In the Scottish Highlands, see if you can spot the Loch Ness Monster from the tower of Inverness's Urquhart Castle and in Liverpool, wall in the steps of the Beatles. Start your tour in London and see some of the cities iconic sites before transferring to nearby Southampton to board the Norwegian Spirit for your 11 day cruise. This is surely the best way to experience the British Isles - no packing and unpacking - and experiencing the history of the United Kingdom!

Itinerary

June 24, 2019 - Your Journey Begins

Depart today for your overnight flight bound for London, England!

June 25, 2019 - Welcome to London

After 'crossing the pond', you'll arrive in **London** where you'll be met by your **TRIPS escort**, then set out on a panoramic city tour of London! You'll drive past iconic sights such as **Buckingham Palace, the Tower of London and Big Ben**. Transfer to your hotel later this afternoon to unpack and have time to explore and enjoy dinner on your own.

Overnight: London

June 26, 2019 - Southampton

This morning travel to one of the world's most famous ports, **Southampton**. On arrival this afternoon, board your floating hotel, home for the next 11 days, the **Norwegian Spirit**. Enjoy a late lunch onboard and be sure to be on deck for your **5pm** sailing! (L/D)

June 27, 2019 - At Sea

You have a full day to enjoy the **Norwegian Spirit**. Indulge in a refreshing swim in the pool or enjoy a relaxing dip in one of the hot tubs on deck. Want to test your luck? Check out **Maharajah's Casino** and try your hand at Roulette, Blackjack, slots and more! If you enjoy card games, gather your friend in the Card Room for Bridge or test your skill with board games. There are 17 extraordinary dining options! From a sit down, multi course meal to a mouthwatering burger off the grill, your taste buds will always be in for a thrill! (B/L/D)

June 28, 2019 - Edinburgh (Newhaven), Scotland

Make sure you pack your walking shoes for Edinburgh. Stroll along the medieval **Royal Mile** to the **Palace of Holyroodhouse** to see the Abbey and Queen Mary's chambers. Savor old town's marvelous Georgian and Victorian architecture and marvel at impressive **Edinburgh Castle**, high on its volcanic crag with a fabulous view. Visit **St. Giles' Cathedral** where John Knox once preached. Leave enough time to rest your legs at one of Edinburgh's seaside restaurants to enjoy fresh salmon, scallops,

lamb and prime Angus beef. The Spirit is docked here from **8am to 6pm, plenty of time to enjoy Edinburgh**. (B/L/D)

June 29, 2019 - Inverness (Invergordon), Scotland

Located in the **Scottish Highlands** you'll find a fabulous choice of things to do in Inverness. **Inverness Castle**, in the heart of the city, is one of several castles in the area. The **Corrimony Chambered Cairn**, built some 4,000 years ago continues to fascinate historians. You may elect to enjoy a cruise on nearby **Loch Ness** while on the lookout for "Nessie" the Loch Ness Monster! Your ship is docked here from **7am to 5pm**. (B/L/D)

June 30, 2019 - Kirkwall, Orkney Isles, Scotland

Today stop at one out of the way and remote island, one you'll only see on a cruise like this! The Orkney Isles are starkly beautiful and hold many ancient treasures such as the mysterious **Standing Stones of Stenness** and the **5,000-year-old village of Skara Brae**, discovered with furniture and indoor drains preserved. This is a great place to pop into a pub to chow down on salmon and lamb dishes with the locals and ask about the best place to buy local cashmere, whiskey and crafts. The Spirit is docked here from **7am to 1pm**. (B/L/D)

July 1, 2019 - Glasgow (Greenock), Scotland

Located on the River Clyde, Glasgow is Scotland's cultural center and is home to excellent museums, art galleries and more! The Spirit is docked here from **12pm to 8pm** and you'll find that there is plenty to see and do. The city's most significant historic building is the **12th century Glasgow Cathedral**. Nearby **Pollok House** has an impressive collection of Spanish paintings by El Greco, Goya, Velazquez and others that is a must for art lovers. (B/L/D)

July 2, 2019 - Belfast, Northern Ireland

Dominating the Belfast skyline are the twin shipbuilding cranes named Samson and Goliath situated in the shipyard of **Harland & Wolff** where the **RMS Titanic** was built. You might elect to visit the **Titanic Belfast**, with interactive galleries including recreations of the ship's cabins, the underwater exploration theatre and a moving evocation of the ship's

catastrophic and untimely demise. Opened in 2012 on the centenary of the sinking, it has become the most popular attraction in Northern Ireland. You'll have plenty of time as you are here from **7am to 6pm.** (B/L/D)

July 3, 2019 - Liverpool, UK

Welcome to Liverpool, the **Fab Four's hometown!** You might visit the **The Beatles Story**, with the world's largest permanent exhibition purely devoted to the lives and times of **The Beatles**, the best-selling band in history with the most number-one albums on the British charts. Imagine strolling along the streets of the city that propelled the four young lads to worldwide fame. Did you know that it's also a UNESCO World Heritage City, **home to the oldest Chinese community in Europe** and that Liverpool FC is the only British football club - soccer to you Yanks! - to win 5 European Cups? You certainly won't be short of things to do in Liverpool! The Spirit is docked here from **6am to 4:30pm.** (B/L/D)

July 4, 2019 - Dublin, Ireland

In a city as old as the Vikings, there is plenty to do in **Dublin!** The city has been named **the friendliest in Europe** and one of the top 10 cities in the world to visit. You'll find **brightly colored doors** adorning red brick buildings, ancient manuscripts at **Trinity College** and the iconic hotspot of **St. James' Gate** - home of **Guinness!** While discovering Dublin, stop in a local pub for a pint and bite to eat. You'll find them filled to the rafters with chatter, laughter and lots of characters - it's the best way to connect with the friendly people of Dublin! The Spirit is docked in Dublin from **3am to 11pm.** (B/L/D)

July 5, 2019 - Cork (Cobh), Ireland

Cobh, formally Queenstown, was the **departure point** for 2.5 million Irish who emigrated to North America between 1848 to 1950. And on April 11, 1912 this was the final port of call for the **RMS Titanic** as she set sail across the Atlantic on her maiden voyage. Make sure to stop by the **Heritage Center** with exhibitions that tell the story of the immigration experience as people fled from famine and disease. The charming waterfront is dotted with brightly colored houses overlooked by a splendid cathedral and is the perfect spot an afternoon stroll! You'll have plenty of time as you are here from **11am to 6pm.** (B/L/D)

July 6, 2019 - Portland, England

The Spirit docks in **Portland** today from **12pm to 8pm.** Perhaps best known for quarrying **Portland Stone**, its harbor has played prominent roles during both WWI and WWII and recently was the setting for **sailing events** during the 2012 Olympics. Portland Stone has been used at St. Paul's Cathedral and Buckingham Palace. **Sir Christopher Wren** used 6 million tons of white Portland limestone to rebuild part of London destroyed after the Great Fire of London of 1666. Don't miss the **Portland Museum** with displays telling the story of shipwrecks, smuggling and the history of quarrying on the Isle. (B/L/D)

July 7, 2019 - A Fond Farewell

This morning finds you back in **Southampton** at **5am.** After disembarkation, you'll return to London for your flight home. **Memories of the Ultimate British Isles will be with you for years to come!** (B)
